## **COVID-19 RESPONSE**

Due to the outbreak of the Covid-19 pandemic, S7 Medical Transport has installed several changes to ensure the safety of all patients and employees.

Each Unit (Van) will rotate independently. Each employee has a designated unit that is assigned to them, which cannot be switched, or cross paths. Each Unit consists of a driver, equipment (wheelchair, gurney, locks, tie down belts, other safety equipment), and other materials such as (gloves, face masks, sanitizers, disinfectant wipes, sanitized spray). All units are equipped with a necessary equipment and materials that need to be maintained by the personnel that is assigned to a specific unit.

To ensure the safety of our patients and employees, S7 has suspended carpooling. Patients will not encounter other patients until we believe it is safe to start carpooling again. All equipment and interior will be sanitized and wiped down after each trip. At the beginning of each workday drivers will be screened and temperature will be taken.

We have set these guidelines to ensure that it is safe for our patients and employees to operate with S7 Medical transport. These rules will put S7 in the best position to continue operating during this Global Pandemic.
